The Independent Directors are made aware of their roles, rights and responsibilities.

The Directors of the Company have sufficient access to any information relating to the Company and to interact with the Company’s management. They are given the documents sought by them to enable them to understand the operations and industry segments in which the Company and the subsidiaries operates.

Programme

The Independent Directors are familiarised with the various facets of Business Activities, during which the senior management make the presentations on the Businesses, including updates on macro and micro economic scenario, technology and regulatory developments.

Review of the Programme

The Programme would be reviewed from time to time, as and when required.
